Message from Harvey Flatt, GSV President

Fourth of July Parade

The Stonegate Citizens Association will not be holding a 4th of July parade this year. Our Village is considering holding a parade if there is sufficient interest. It will not in any way replicate what the SCA did in past years. Our parade will be with cars only and no personal contact (not even at 6 feet apart) and no follow up activities at the pool or anywhere else after the parade.

We would plan to assemble at Stonegate Elementary School parking lot at noon on the 4th in our cars, and everyone would stay in their vehicles. Village volunteers already have car magnet signs identifying them as volunteers of the Village. These should, of course, be put on the cars for the parade. Board members and some Village members also have yard signs with the name of the Village, which can be displayed from the car. We may have additional signs for those who want them. Or you can make your own signs, or have your grandchildren make a sign for you. When everyone is in place, we will drive a predetermined route through the community, and when we reach the endpoint, everyone will drive home.

If we get enough people to sign up to do this and we go ahead with plans for the parade, we will put out the word on the Stonegate Listserv and publicize it as much as possible, so hopefully, there will be a large community turn out to see us drive by.
